3. Treasurers report delivered verbally by Janet Shapiro. [attached] There is enough surplus balance that Troika is asked to recommend amounts to be spent, and some proposals. Health Group money remains ring-fenced for future activity. Janet thanked.

4. Editors report read verbally by Rachel Cohen. Trude Sundberg and Rachel Cohen continue on but are somewhat overwhelmed by workload. Larry Brownstein continues as book editor. 


